

Town of Mackford
Regular Town Board Meeting Minutes
April 21st, 2026

The meeting was held at the Town of Mackford Town Hall, N2270 County Road A, Markesan, WI 53946. Notice of this meeting was given by posting on the Town Hall message board and the Town's website.

Call to Order

- Chairman Davison called the regular town board meeting to order at 7:20 PM. Supervisor Gigstead and Treasurer Krentz were absent. There were 2 citizens from the Town also in attendance.
- Roll Call: Steve Davison - 6, JJ Gigstead - 2 + 52 miles, Roger Schure - 2, Brittany Krentz - 0, Andrea Dillie - 2

Agenda

- The agenda was read. Supervisor Schure made a motion to accept the agenda as presented. Chairman Davison seconded; the motion carried 2-0.

Minutes

- The minutes from the February 16th, 2026 town board meeting were reviewed (the March regular town board meeting was cancelled due to weather). Supervisor Schure made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Chairman Davison seconded; the motion carried 2-0.

Public Comments (3-Minute Limit)

- Gayle Schultz, who is the Town of Mackford Chief Election Inspector, noted that the April 7th election went smoothly.
- The microwave has died. Clerk Dillie will purchase a new one.
- Welsey James spoke with Modern Rental about spraying the lawn. They submitted a quote for the board to review. No action was taken at this time.
- Supervisor Schure noted that the stop sign at the corner of Mackford Hill Road and Hickory Drive is leaning. Wesley James will fix it.
- Clerk Dillie will contact Shipp Lawn Services regarding lawn care for 2026.

Vouchers/Bills

- Supervisor Schure made a motion to approve the vouchers/bills. Chairman Davison seconded; the motion carried 2-0.

Treasurer's Report

- The board reviewed the treasurer's report. Chairman Davison made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Supervisor Schure seconded; the motion carried 2-0.

Old Business

Road Report

- There are a few potholes to fill on Union Road and Manchester Street. We will patch those.
- The town hall parking lot needs to be repaired. Bids will be requested and the funds will come from the Gastra account.
- Supervisor Schure made a motion to get bids for the following 2026 Road Projects. Chairman Davison seconded; the motion carried 2-0.
 - Pulverize with water injection, grade and compact approximately 0.5 miles of Union Road from Lake Maria Road to Prairie Road.
 - Seal coating half to all of Brave Road.
 - Blacktop wedge approximately 1.25 miles of Hickory Drive.

- Brush cutting needs to happen on Lake Maria Road between County Roads O and U, Hickory Drive, Sunny Drive, Prairie Drive, and Tichora Road. Supervisor Schure will contact Kinas Excavating.
- There is someone who will take fallen trees that are on Hickory Drive and Lovers Lane.

New Business

Town Hall Roof

- The roof needs to be replaced. The board will get quotes for both shingles and steel. No action was taken at this time.

2026 Transportation Funding Resolution 2026-01

- The Wisconsin Towns Association has been working to stabilize the funding for roads. The resolution proposed urges the Governor of Wisconsin and the State Legislature to enact a comprehensive, sustainable funding solution. Chairman Davison made a motion to adopt the resolution. Supervisor Schure seconded; the motion carried 2-0. Clerk Dillie will email copies to WTA, the Governor's office, and all members of the State Senate and Assembly representing the Town of Mackford.

Recycling Ordinance 2026-01

- The Wisconsin DNR is requiring all RUs to adopt an updated recycling ordinance. The ordinance was reviewed. Chairman Davison made a motion to adopt the revised recycling ordinance. Supervisor Schure seconded; the motion carried 2-0.

Liquor License Request

- A party that has purchased a property in the City of Green Lake has reached out inquiring if the Town of Mackford had any licenses available. Since it's been many years since the Town of Mackford issued liquor licenses, it's unknown if we even have any available or if we want to issue one to a property not in the Town of Mackford. No action was taken at this time.

Adjourn: Supervisor Schure moved to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Davison seconded; the motion carried 2-0 to adjourn at 8:24 PM
